Myopia, also known as short-sightedness or near-sightedness, is a common eye condition causing distant objects to appear blurred.

Myopia typically presents in childhood as it is due to the eyeball growing longer than needed during childhood growth..

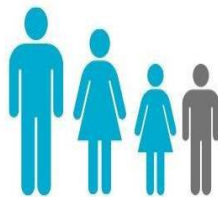

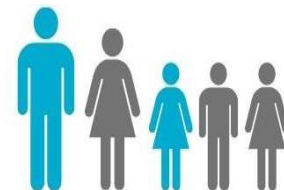

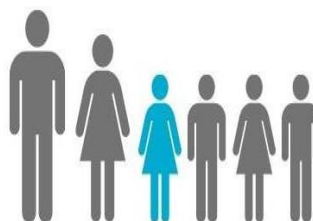
1 IN 2
